PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

The Occupational Certificate: Organisational Risk Practitioner equips learners with the knowledge, practical skills, and workplace experience to effectively implement and manage risk management frameworks within an organisation. This qualification supports Risk Officers by preparing learners to facilitate risk management activities, assess risks, create partnerships, and develop treatment plans, ensuring the alignment of risk strategies with organisational objectives.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A National Senior Certificate (NSC) or Senior Certificate with endorsement for diploma studies.
- A National Certificate (Vocational) at NQF Level 4.
- Communication at NQF Level 4.
- Mathematical Literacy at NQF Level 4.
- 2 – 3 years exposure and experience in the risk environment.
- Alternatively, access may be granted through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), considering learner work experience.

RECOMMENDED TARGET AUDIENCE

This qualification is designed for:

- Individuals aiming to start a career in organisational risk management.
- Employees in risk-related roles, such as compliance officers, auditors, or general controllers, seeking formal qualifications.
- Business managers responsible for risk-related decision-making.
- Professionals transitioning into the risk management sector.
